Redbourn Celebrates 2012 is a group made up of sports clubs, community organisations and businesses in the village that have come together to plan a series of events to celebrate the fact that London is hosting the **Olympic** and **Paralympic Games** in **2012**. The events are designed to engage residents young and old from Redbourn to come together and celebrate through a range of sporting and cultural activities.

The torch relay will start at the Recreation Centre at 10.00am on **Saturday 16 June 2012** and proceed through the streets of the the village arriving on the common at 12.30pm. The torch will signify the start of our 2012 village celebrations. In the afternoon the scouts will be hosting their annual fete on the common which will include a BBQ and range of activities with **The Cricketers** providing the bar.

The torch will have been designed by a young person from the village and turned into production courtesy of a local secondary school.

Those carrying the torch will do so for approx 300-500m (subject to the number of participants) along flat paths in the village. We hope to be able to enable

those wishing to take part to be able to travel with the torch through or near to the street in which they live. This really is an inclusive opportunity for young and old, able bodied and those with a disability (including people in wheelchairs) to take part.

We are keen that as many people as possible get to experience the fun and excitement and travel with the torch. All nominations are welcome.

We are however particularly keen to recognise those living in the village who have done something special recently or in the past, if you know someone who you think has:

- 1) **Made a difference to peoples lives through volunteering their time**
- 2) **Done something to make a difference to village life**
- 3) **Achieved something exceptional**
- 4) **Is an inspiration to you and others**

Then we really want to hear about them and get them involved.
